



### BRIEF HISTORY

- 1743 Built as a French Protestant Church.
- 1819 Methodist Chapel.
- 1898 Spitalfields Great Synagogue.
- 1976 The Brick Lane Jamme Masjid.

This is one of the largest mosques in the capital. On a Friday it has become increasingly difficult to accommodate the full congregation, as a result of which people are having to pray on stairs and hallways.

Full refurbishment of the Masjid including new roof, windows and erecting a minaret. Total cost for this will be in the region of £4m.
