



BRIEF HISTORY

Ebrahim College was founded in 2003 with the aim of providing future leaders of the Islamic community access to the best of both Islamic and secular education.

PRESENT ON GOING PROJECT AND ACTIVITIES

The College teaches the Full Alimiyah programme in English and Arabic (the only institute in the UK to do this) alongside a comprehensive programme of A-Levels and GCSE's.

The College is also in negotiation with a well known British University to deliver a BA in Islamic Sciences and Society, which will provide future graduating Alims with a recognised qualification.

The college operates on student fees, community support and Qarda-E- Hassanah loans.

FUTURE PLAN

Each student is charged a fee of £2,500 to study at EC. Due to the high costs of delivering A-levels, it actually costs around £4,000 for a student to study at EC, this is subsidised to reduce barriers to keen students. As a result the College operates on an annual deficit of around £200,000, which has to be raised from the Muslim community.

The College business model is relying on receiving funding from the local government for its A-level programme, negotiations are still ongoing with the LSC (government agency handling further education funding)

FUNDS NEEDED

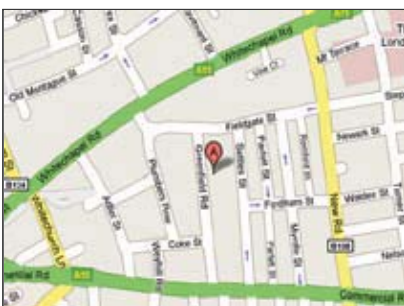
