

IPSWICH MOSQUE



BRIEF HISTORY

The mosque was established in a former fire station in Bond Street in the 1980s, but as the number of Muslims in the town has increased it has become increasingly cramped.

Up to 400 men now attend Friday prayers at the mosque every week. Eventually the Muslim community in Ipswich hopes to have a completely new £750,000 purpose-built mosque on the Bond Street site, but there is much fund-raising to be undertaken first.

Earlier this year a new community centre was opened at the mosque which provided more space for worship and activities in general and the development into Upper Orwell Street would be the second major expansion of the centre.

PRESENT ON GOING PROJECT AND ACTIVITIES

Bought a building for £261,000. From 2 previous Channel 5 appeals we have raised £120,000. To refurbish the building we bought, to make it usable for mosque will cost around £120,000. This will include bigger wudhu area and body washing facilities for the deceased

FUTURE PLAN

To build a purpose built Mosque within our current site which we have plan for and agreed by the local council. The Mosque will include a Madrasah. To do this will cost around £500,000

FUNDS NEEDED

We immediately need funds for Refurbishment including Wudhu Khana, Prayer carpet, doors, windows, lights and fans.
