



BRIEF HISTORY

Madani Girls School, founded in September 1991, is a Secondary Independent School for Muslim girls. Situated in the East End of London, it serves the local community, in order to fulfil the demands of a single sex girls' school in Tower Hamlets and the surrounding areas. Initially it started with only 17 students.

In 2001 the school moved to its present site in Myrdle Street to premises, which was previously occupied by Grenfell Primary School. The school is Ofsted and DfEE registered and currently has over 200 students.

PRESENT ON GOING PROJECT AND ACTIVITIES

To purchase the current school building for £1.3m . The council have currently placed a time limit on completion of purchase, if purchase is not completed within the time limit, the school will have to vacate for the building to be made available for auction.

FUTURE PLAN

Once purchase can be made, refurbishment work is required in order to increase classrooms and to give the school a good face lift. Future OFSTED inspection will require that classrooms are fully equipped and fit for purpose.

FUNDS NEEDED

£330,000 - required to complete the purchase.
£450,000 - required for the refurbishment work.
