A UK-based international relief and development agency, Muslim Aid has been working for over two decades to help save and improve the lives of millions in over 70 of the world’s poorest countries.

PRESENT ON GOING PROJECT AND ACTIVITIES

In December 2007 Muslim Aid and Channel 5 unveiled plans to build two villages in the cyclone hit areas named “Shahjalal & Shahporan Village”. Each of these villages will have 360 houses named after the 360 Awliya of Shahjalal and Shahporan, as well as mosques, schools and medical centres.

FUTURE PLAN

Our mission is empowering and building the capacity of local people in some of the world’s poorest countries. This means that we give individuals the resources and skills necessary to tackle the problems confronting their own communities.

Whilst many relief agencies pack up and go home after providing initial emergency aid in the aftermath of a disaster, we stay!

FUNDS NEEDED

£1000 is required to build each house in the Shahjalal and Shahporan villages. Construction work has already started and a number of solid, concrete houses which can withstand future adverse weather conditions, have been built.

With your generosity, help and support we need a total sum of £720,000 (£1000 for each house) to complete the two villages. When complete, Inshallah, this project will be a historic landmark for the British Bangladeshi community and a spectacular example for the rest of the world.
