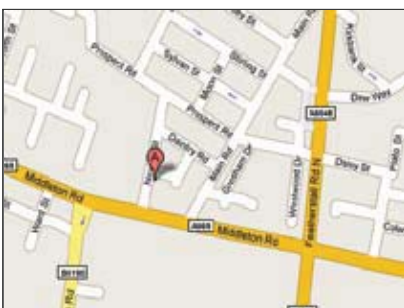




BRIEF HISTORY

In 1990 a group of dedicated Muslims in Oldham embarked upon a mission to provide facilities and services for the communities in Oldham and decided to acquire a property. As the work grew over the years another two properties were bought on Chaderton Way to cater for the ever increasing needs of the community.

At first it seemed generously spacious, but before long it began to overflow, there was hardly room for the growing number of projects based at the centre. In April 2007, the OMC management decided to re-locate the OMC at Compass House after sale of £1.9m was agreed. After intensive fundraising campaigns and donations from the local community, OMC raised enough money to receive the keys for Compass House in January 2008 and on 24th February 2008 the doors of the new Oldham Muslim Centre opened to the public.
