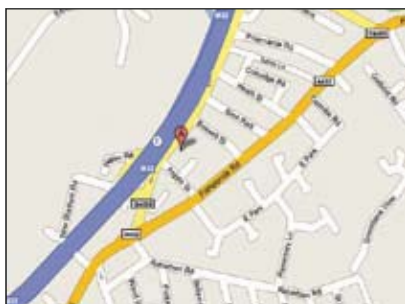
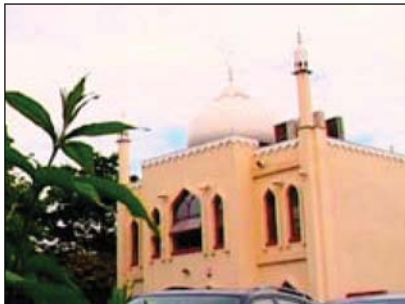




SHAHJALAL JAME MOSQUE



BRIEF HISTORY

Established in 1998, to cater for the Bangladeshi community within Bristol, Bath and surrounding areas. Initially two shops were bought and demolished in order to build a purpose built mosque which would be a landmark in Bristol led by the Chairman of the board of Trustees, Ahmed us Samad Chowdhury JP.

PRESENT ON GOING PROJECT AND ACTIVITIES

Having taken a good part of 10 years to complete, the project is nearly complete accommodating 600 muslims. However, there is still an outstanding loan of £80,000 which needs to be paid immediately.

FUTURE PLAN

The community can be proud of the achievement of the only West England's purpose built Shahjalal Jami Mosque. Once the debt has been cleared, the project can finance itself and inshallah once the debt is repaid the Shahjalal Mosque can move forward and build on it's successes by extending the services currently provided and work towards establishing as much needed multi purpose Islamic Centre.

FUNDS NEEDED

£80,000 is needed to pay off and clear the remaining debt. With the help of previous Channel 5 fundraising appeals and other generous donations, the original loan of £280,000 has come down to only £80,000. We urge the community to come forward and make this mosque debt free.
